**Class X:** Two Periodic Tests-I and II, Half Yearly, Pre Board-I and Pre Board-II will be conducted.

✦ **Multiple Assessment (05 Marks)**: The subject teacher will determine the type and frequency of these assessments. Teachers will use diverse techniques to assess the learners viz. observation, oral tests, individual or group work, class discussion, field work, concept maps, graphics, visual representation etc. The weightage of this component will be of 05 marks.

✦ **Portfolio (05 Marks)**: Class work, artifacts, peer assessment, self assessment, reflections, narrations, journals, achievements of the student in the subject.
