

The constructive and systematic deliberation results in enhancing their critical thinking abilities as well as develops their cognitive, social, and emotional capabilities. The cluster level competition was held in the MP Hall of the school as per the AWWA guidelines, on 30th of June 2022, between the students of APS, Dagshai and the APS, Chandimandir. The event was graced by the Chairperson of AWWA Mrs Preeti Dhiman. Students of APS Chandimandir won the competition and went on to compete at the Command level.
