

PROMOTION CRITERIA : CLASSES III– XII

CLASSES III – VIII

- As per CBSE Rules.

CLASSES IX& XI

- **CLASS IX:** A student must obtain a minimum of 33% in each subject (Theory & Practical/Internal Assessment) and in the aggregate for promotion to Class X. **Retest** can be given in **two subjects** only in Class IX for promotion to class X.
- **CLASS XI:** A student must obtain a minimum of 33% in each subject (separate pass in Theory & Practical/Internal Assessment) and in the aggregate for promotion to Class XII. **Retest** can be given in **one subject** only in Class XI for promotion to Class XII.

CLASSES X & XII

- A student must obtain a minimum of 33% in each subject (Theory & Practical/Project/Internal Assessment) to pass Class X Exam.
- A student must obtain a minimum of 33% in each subject (separate pass in Theory & Practical/Project/Internal Assessment) to pass Class XII Examination.

❖ IMPORTANT NOTES

- **Attendance:** It is compulsory for every student to appear in Term-I and Term-II Exam Exam. A minimum of 75% of total attendance is mandatory.
- **Introduction of Two Levels of Maths for AISSCE (Class X):** CBSE has introduced two levels of Maths for Class X students only.
 - **Standard Level:** For students who wish to opt for Maths at Senior Secondary Level.
 - **Basic Level:** For students who are not keen to pursue Maths at Senior Secondary Level. Syllabus, class-room teaching and internal assessment for both the levels remain the same. However, CBSE has allowed students who opt for Maths (Basic) in Class X, and are desirous of pursuing Maths in Class XI to opt for it as a onetime measure subject to approval by the School Principal.
- **There shall be no two levels of assessment for Maths in Class IX.**
